



## CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct identifies the standard of behaviour which is expected of all Orillia Renegades Ladies Hockey League (OLHL) Members, including coaches.

OLHL is committed to providing a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. Members of the OLHL shall conduct themselves at all times in a fair and responsible manner. Members shall refrain from comments or behaviours which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, behaviour which constitutes harassment, abuse, bullying or cyber-bullying will not be tolerated by the OLHL.

During the course of all OLHL activities and events, members shall avoid behaviour which brings OLHL members or the sport of hockey into disrepute, including but not limited to abusive use of alcohol and non-medical use of drugs. Members shall not use unlawful or unauthorized drugs/narcotics or performance enhancing drugs or methods.

Members of the OLHL shall not engage in activity or behaviour which endangers the safety of others.

OLHL members shall at all times adhere to Handbook, Constitution, By-Laws, Regulations, Rules, Policies, Procedures, Code of Conduct and other related materials in accordance with the current affiliated league insurer.
