Suspension Protocol

The League fully adheres to the CARHA Hockey Official Rule Book and the game referees in each League game shall have the power to assess, as they see fit, penalties that may lead to suspensions. The League may assess such further and other suspensions as it deems fit and without consultation with other parties. All Members, while present on the property of any arena where a League game or practice is to be held, shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the League. All Members are subject to the provisions of these Suspension Guidelines and the League expects Members to be fully acquainted with the CARHA Hockey Official Rule Book and to abide by any suspensions assessed by the League.

A Member who is suspended may not, during the entire period of her suspension:

- a) enter the Players' Area;
- b) communicate in any way with the players or officials of her team while the suspended Member is in the arena;
- c) coach, play for or otherwise be involved with any other team in the League;
- d) act as a referee, game official, arena official or official of the League

When a player or coach receives a suspendable offence (Game Misconduct, Match Penalty, Gross Misconduct or any game ejection, (5 min major) the Team Manager is to notify the Registrar asap. The suspended players name, team, offence which was handed out by the official, and the officials full name will need to be provided. If during a tournament this means before your next game.

Registrar will submit a suspension report to CARHA online. It is **only acceptable to send it online** at <http://carhahockey.ca/915/notice-of-suspension>. Director will confirm suspensions and also clear players to play. Players that receive a suspension that has duration of 3 games or more will be sent a letter from CARHA as well as the league convener to keep on file.

All challenges to suspension should follow the complaints procedure.
